

## Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) 2022-23

The government believes that the Early Years Pupil Premium, which is additional to main school funding, is the best way to address the current underlying inequalities between children eligible for free school meals (FSM)/ children on the deprivation index and their peers by ensuring that funding to tackle disadvantage reaches the pupils who need it most.

- Yoga teacher has been a success, as the children learn how to regulate their emotions, breathing and improves balance and core strength. This is reflected in the summer term data where EYPP out perform the non EYPP cohort.
- Children attending lunch club are prepared for meal times in reception class, increasing independence and self-care skills. Parents are able to attend appointments / meetings without the child
- Shadowing practitioner will learn from an experienced skilled yoga teacher. Provision in this area will be enhanced with more resources from Sept 2023.
- Children have experiences they would not normally encounter therefore increasing their cultural capital and understanding of the world around them.
